Our Community Gardening Group

Many moons ago, pre COVID, the Community Gardens Committee of CMUC accepted an offer of some 20 planter boxes from FareShare, a charity based in Abbottsford which produces low cost meals for those in need. The boxes had been made by prisoners, but FareShare no longer needed them, and most were in need of maintenance and repair.

At the time, we anticipated a use for them ourselves, and set about repairing and upgrading the boxes, which have been stored in the Mentone UC hall in Eblana Ave. Mentone.

However, as reported previously, most of the various initiatives of our wee committee have unfortunately come to nought, aside from a modest Backyard Sharing project (*more on that another time*). As a result, we have recently found ourselves post COVID with several good quality planter boxes in need of a good home.

After several enquiries, a dozen have now been dispatched. Six have been enthusiastically accepted by Hampton Park UC (which runs a community garden and offers community meals twice a week); one by the Murrumbeena Community Garden, associated with Murrumbeena UC; and five by the Carnegie Community Laneways Garden and Gallery – recommended by the Murrumbeena Community Garden.





